MARRIAGE PREPARATION STEPS

Meet with Pastor or Deacon

After you become engaged, contact your parish to set up a meeting with a priest or deacon to set the date and discuss your marriage preparation.

2 Marriage Preparation Inventory

A series of questions designed to assess each of your habits, expectations, and values, providing a personalized profile that will be reviewed with you by your pastor, deacon, delegate, or a designated mentor couple. Ask your pastor for information to register.

3 Marriage Preparation Course

The Diocese of Raleigh offers an excellent educational component, in English or Spanish, that is interactive and designed to introduce you to the rich teachings on the sacrament of matrimony, as well as important life skills.

4 Natural Family Planning

When you begin to start a family, you may have difficulties trying to conceive or want a healthy option for spacing children. Fertility awareness is not only effective for postponing pregnancy organically, it is also highly effective in overcoming obstacles that inhibit becoming parents.

5 Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Church invites all Catholics to prepare themselves spiritually prior to marriage by celebrating the sacrament of reconciliation. Non-Catholics may also benefit from spiritual direction from a priest or deacon.

6 Final Meeting w/ Pastor or Deacon

Regularly communicate with your priest or deacon, and meet with him just prior to your marriage.
